**2,508,000 LITRES** of water

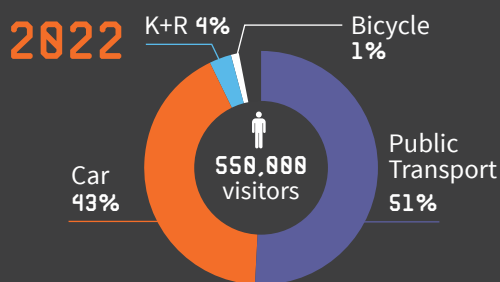


With the use of waterless urinals, over the past **5 years**, **32,000,000 LITRES** of water has been saved.

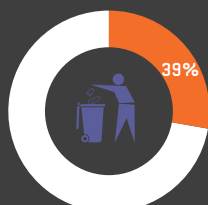

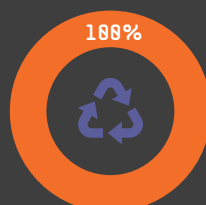
